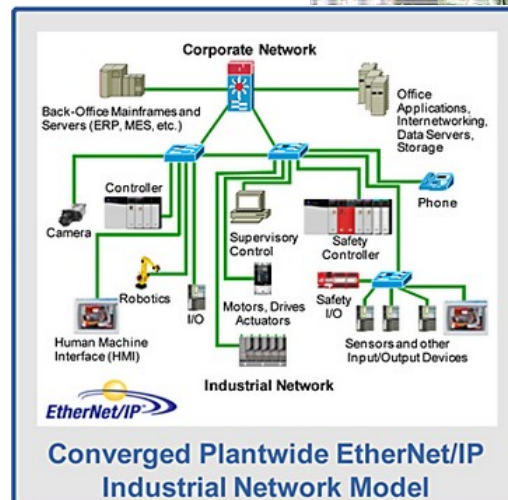
### SESSION INFORMATION
